

## Tamborine Mountain Bridge Club

### Rules and Regulations

<b>MOBILE PHONES</b>	Mobile phones are not to be used in playing areas. They must be turned off or on silent.
<b>ETIQUETTE</b>	Courtesy at the Bridge table means doing nothing to cause discomfort to others.
<b>SMOKING</b>	No smoking anywhere inside the building or within 2 metres of an open window.
<b>PERFUME</b>	Perfume can result in an allergic reaction for some members, in view of this it is requested perfume not be worn.
<b>SEATING</b>	Players should be seated 15 minutes prior to play
<b>DRESS</b>	Players should observe a reasonable standard of dress (smart casual) No singlets, football shorts, thongs or bare feet.
<b>CONTACT DETAILS</b>	Change of contact details should be advised to the Secretary ASAP
<b>COMPLAINTS</b>	Any complaint should be forwarded to the Secretary in writing – verbal or Unsigned complaints will not be addressed.
<b>REGULATION</b>	QBA regulations will apply at all times.
<b>SYSTEMS</b>	Only Green or Blue Systems are allowed at club sessions.
<b>SYSTEM CARDS</b>	A fully completed current system card is required for each pair at Club sessions. For congress and major competitions, 2 System Cards per pair are required.
<b>BOARD MOVEMENT</b>	North/South to be responsible for placing and moving boards.
<b>CARDS</b>	Must be counted before play.
<b>OPENING LEAD</b>	The opening lead is to be made face down.
<b>SCORING</b>	North/South is responsible for scoring & East/West is responsible for checking each score and OK-ing.
<b>TALKING</b>	Talking at table during play should be quiet and kept to a minimum. No discussion should occur about hand just played.
<b>DIRECTOR</b>	The Director must be called for any Infraction of the laws including rudeness & unethical behaviour.
<b>SCORING ERRORS</b>	Should be reported to the Director during play.
<b>SLOW PLAY</b>	Each pair may have only one average board per session for slow play. Other late boards shall be allocated an Average Minus, with an Average Plus to the opposition.
<b>DEFIBRILLATOR</b>	The Club has a Defibrillator and will show Video of Instructions periodically, to ensure members are able to use in the case of an emergency.
<b>AFTER PLAY</b>	To spread the work load it is appreciated that players assist with: Cups/glasses to be placed in dishwasher after use – kitchen to be left clean and tidy – waste baskets to be emptied into appropriate bins – boards to be replaced – windows closed and locked - Bridgemates to be returned to the box.
<b>DEALING</b>	Teams of two/ three are required to deal with boxes of boards as per roster.

**MEMBERSHIP**

Membership must be paid electronically, by cheque or cash at Suncorp to club bank account

**CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP**

If Cup and Plate winner are the same then plate goes to 2nd highest Novice Pair

Members must have played a minimum of 20 sessions in the previous 12 Months to be eligible for Club Championship Events

Minimum 8 tables for Pairs

Only financial club members are eligible to play

Half table allowed for Pairs if a barometer movement used as recommended by the QBA
